

10 Questions to Ask Before Trusting a Professional Credential

A practical checklist for employers, HR teams, universities, clients and professionals.

How to use this checklist

Mark Yes only when you have clear evidence, Unsure when evidence is incomplete, and No when the credential does not meet the test. This checklist supports due diligence; it is not a Cognicert assessment or endorsement of a third-party credential.

Interpret your result

Strong evidence	8-10 Yes answers, including independent verification and current-status confirmation. Continue normal role-specific checks.
Needs further verification	5-7 Yes answers, or any uncertainty about who issued the credential, the assessment or current status. Request more evidence before relying on it.
Insufficient evidence	0-4 Yes answers, or no credible evidence of assessment and verification. Do not treat the document alone as proof of competence.

Why this matters

AI can accelerate learning and help people communicate what they know. It can also make expertise easier to present. As presenting expertise becomes easier, evidence of expertise becomes more important. Reliable professional certification should connect defined competence requirements, meaningful assessment, a certification decision and a credential whose authenticity and current status can be checked.
